GREAT SKI RACE


The Great Ski Race was again a huge success, and the largest single cross-country ski race in the West, with 650 skiers taking on the 30 kilometer course.

The race is the Tahoe Nordic Search and Rescue Team's major fundraising event of the year, and this year raised more than \$5,000.


